

SUMMARY
REGULAR BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING
APRIL 19, 2010

➤ Non-Renewals

A final decision will be made on the non-renewal of three administrative contracts at a special meeting of the Board of Education on April 26, 2010.

➤ Transition and Renovations

A transition team, which consists of community members, support staff, teachers and administrators met on April 8, 2010, to discuss the challenges the district will need to overcome to have a successful transition from the Intermediate School. The transition team will be meeting at the Middle School on April 22, 2010 at 3:45 p.m.

The Middle School renovation project is off to a good start. Kingscott & Associates is working on the final design decisions with Mr. Mansfield. Once the plans are complete, they will be submitted to the State for review around April 28, 2010, and bid packages will be reviewed around that date. Bob McGraw from Kingscott will be at the April 26, 2010, special Board of Education meeting to present an overview of drawings to the Board and answer any questions about design, bids, etc.

➤ Food Service Report

The Board will discuss increasing food service prices at the May 17, 2010, regular Board of Education meeting.

➤ Civil Rights Language

Mr. Vagts reviewed the corrections and missing language in Board policy as a result of the Civil Rights Audit about a year ago. A decision was made to approve the Civil Rights Policy 2450.

➤ Title I Federal Requirement in Board Policy

Mr. Vagts informed the Board about the change needed in Board Policy for Title I.

➤ Special Education Brochure

A decision was made to approve the Special Education Brochure.

➤ Superintendent's Contract Extension

A decision was made to extend the contract of the superintendent for one year through June 30, 2012.
