

To house 4th Grade at the Primary School, we will need four more additional rooms because the current 3rd grade is a large class. Here's how to get those four rooms:

- 4th Grade, Room 1 - Cut 3rd grade next year to three sections, which adds a room; (Classroom 4)
- 4th Grade, Room 2 - Use the art room, with the Art teacher going to the classrooms, "Art on a Cart"; (Art Room)
- 4th Grade, Room 3 - Use one of the Special Education rooms and have that teacher provide service within regular education classes; (Classroom 2)
- There are three options for 4th Grade, Room 4:
 - A. Use one of the pre-school rooms (Classroom 20) which means building a pre-school room in one of the locker room areas next to the Day Care. One of the current 3rd grade rooms (Classroom 1) would be moved to Classroom 20, which would put all the 3rd grade rooms in one section of the building. Classroom 1 then becomes a 4th Grade room.
 - B. Cut a Kindergarten classroom, going from five sections to four (Classroom 5).
 - C. Use the Music Room, with the Music teacher going into individual classrooms.

Red Sections of Map Diagram as these rooms are currently used:

- Classrooms 1 and 4 – 3rd Grade rooms
- Classroom 2 – Special Education room
- Classroom 5 – Kindergarten
- Classroom 20 – Pre-School
- Art Room – for K-3 Art classes
- Music Room – for K-3 Music classes
- There is a locker room on both sides of the Day Care room.
